



## **About: Nihao - Food Bank Initiative**

#### The Problem:

Before the COVID-19 pandemic began, food insecurity in America was at the lowest rate it had been in 20 years, and yet 35.2 million people including 10.7 million children did not know where their next meal would come from.

Research from Feeding America shows that the COVID-19 crisis is likely to reverse any progress made over the past decade as millions of people have been displaced from their jobs. These newly hungry neighbors now stand alongside those who were already facing food insecurity before the pandemic began.

Preliminary studies suggest that more than 50 million people across America, including 17 million children may now be facing food insecurity in the wake of COVID-19.

The North Texas Food Bank (NTFB), as part of Feeding America's network, is dedicated to closing this hunger gap by providing nutritious food to hungry children, families, and seniors in North Texas.

Within its 13 County service area, NTFB is partnered with over 200 Agencies like food pantries and homeless shelters. Through this network, NTFB is providing access to nutritious food for more than 900,000 people who are food insecure, up from 700,000 before COVID-19. This elevated need is projected to last for the foreseeable future.

#### The Nihao Solution:

Nihao: Food Bank Initiative is a volunteer-driven grassroots movement, focused on raising awareness about hunger in the USA, improving community engagement, as well as directing resources and contributions toward NTFB to fight hunger.

Our initiative galvanizes and mobilizes resources of the Chinese diaspora by:

- Increasing hunger awareness
- Organizing volunteers
- Conducting food drives
- Raising crucial funds

Led by co-chairs and a steering committee comprised of passionate supporters and volunteers, the Nihao movement operates in a non-political, non-religious, robust ecosystem that puts the cause ahead of individual egos.

Nihao: Food Bank Initiative has a twofold vision: 1) Engage in the fight against hunger with our resources to ensure no one goes hungry. 2) Unify the community as a cohesive force so that the Chinese American diaspora is recognized as a leader in fighting hunger.
